PREAMBLES TO DAYWORK RATES

- 1. Daywork rates or prices shall only be used for payment for works executed on a Daywork basis pursuant to Clause 25.2 of the Conditions of Contract. No work shall be carried out on a Daywork basis except when ordered in writing by the Superintending Officer.
- 2. The Contractor/Tenderer shall insert the Dayworks Rates/Prices for labour and plant as listed in the schdules/tables appearing hereinafter. However, such Dayworks Rates/Prices inserted by the Contractor/Tenderer shall be subjected to the agreement of the Superintending Officer as to the reasonableness and shall before the signing of the Contract be adjusted as the Superintending Officer may reasonable require. He may also be required to justify the Daywork Rates/Prices tendered by him requested by the Superintending Officer.
- 3. The rates entered for labour shall be deemed to include all on-costs associated with the employment of such labour including (inter alia), head office charges, overhead charges, profit, site supervision and staff, insurances, wages, travelling time and expanses, subsistence allowances, time lost due to inclement weather, bonus, holiday and sick pay, and any other employee's fringe benefit(s), small tools and consumable stores, temporary tracks, ladders, staging scaffolding and all items of a similar nature unless these are provided or set-up exclusively for daywork.
- 4. The wages of gangers and leading hands working with their gangs shall be paid for at the appropriate rates, but the time of walking gangers, sub-foremen and foremen will not be included and shall be deemed to be included in the rates entered for labour under site supervision and staff.
- 5. Only time on work actually done will be allowed. A "DAY" is considered to be normal working day 8 hours. Fractions of a day will be paid for "PRO RATA". No allowance shall be made for tea breaks, rest periods, standing/idling or travelling time whether on or off the Site.

6. Payment for overtime work, if chargeable and approved by the S.O. shall be made at the rates entered herein, but the times so worked as overtime shall be adjusted in the same proportion as that used for paying the normal workmen on the Site and approved by the S.O. Thus if a man works 1 hour overtime for which the rate payable is double time, payment shall be made for 2 hours at the rate entered in the Daywork Schedule.

Notes: Overtime is working time over and above 8 hours per working day including Saturday or 48 hours a week.

The cost of special watching and lighting necessitated by daywork shall be included in the rates.

- 7. As a condition precedent to any right to any payment, the Contractor shall produce for verification to the Superintending Officer, vouchers, receipts and wages books specifying the time and labour and plant employed and materials used as per clause 25.2 of the Conditions of Contract.
- 8. The Daywork Rates/Prices for plant shall apply to all plant irrespective whether the plant is hired or owned by the Contractor. The rates/prices shall cover all the contractor's obligations whatsoever in providing and maintaining such plant at the place of work including fuel, lubricants and other consumable spares, overhauls repairs, maintenance and replacement, all auxiliary/ancillary equipment necessary for efficient operation and use of the plant, overhead charges and profit but <u>excluding</u> operator/driver and attendant (who shall be paid separately as labour).
- 9. Payment for mechanically operated plant shall be made only at such times as the plant is engaged in daywork and shall exclude all standing, idle or down time.
- 10. If any workmen or items of plant on daywork do not readily belong to any classification included in the Schedule or inserted by the Contractors at the time of tendering, the S.O. shall determine the equivalent classification to be adopted for such workmen or items of plant, and payment for such will be made accordingly.
- 11. The daywork rates entered hereunder and agreed by the S.O. shall not be further subjected to the fifteen percent (15%) addition as stipulated in Clause 25.2 of the Conditions of Contract.
